





बाल दिवस

"बाल दिवन" का अर्थ है, 'बच्चों का दिन'। बच्चे ही किसी देश की वास्तविक संपत्ति हुआ करते हैं। ये ही बच्चे आनेवाले कल के कर्णधार है। बच्चे जो आन की कोमल कलियाँ है वे ही कल के खिलने बाले फूल हुआ करते हैं। कहने का तात्पर्य है कि आज भी बच्चों का है और कल भी। अतः पत्येक देश का कर्तव्य है कि वह अपने देश के बच्चों के सर्वांगीण विकास की ओर समुचित च्यान दे। इन्ही बातों को च्यान में रखकर हमारे देश में प्रतिवर्ष १४ नवंबर को 'बाल दिवस' के रूप में मनाया जाता है।

१ ४ नवंबर स्वतंत्र भारत के प्रथम प्रधानमंत्री स्वर्गीय पंडित जवाहरलाल नेहरूजी का जन्मदिवस भी है। पं. नेहरू को मुलाब के फूल और मुलाब के फूल के समान खिले रहनेवाले प्यारे-प्यारे बच्चे बहुत अधिक प्रिय थे। इसीलिए उन्होंने अपने जन्मदिन को बच्चों का दिन 'बाल दिवस' के रूप में मनाया। स्वयं बच्चे भी नेहरू जी को बहुत अधिक प्यार किया करते थे और वे उन्हें प्यार से 'चाचा नेहरू' कह कर पुकारते थे। नेहरू जी प्रायः बच्चों के बीच पुल-मिल जाते थे। पं. नेहरू जी को बच्चों से इतना अधिक प्यार था कि वे बहुत अधिक व्यस्त रहने पर भी बच्चों के लिए समय अवश्य निकाल लेते थे। यही नहीं कभी-कभी तो वे रास्ते में किसी क्षण किसी भी बच्चे को देखकर अपनी गाड़ी रूकवा कर उस बच्चे को गोद में उठाकर पुचकारते थे तथा उससे बाते करने लग जाते थे।

'बास दिवस' मनाने का प्रयोजन यह भी है कि बच्चे अपने देश का भविष्य हुआ करते हैं अतः उनके सासन-पासन, शिक्षा-दीक्षा, प्रगति और विकास आदि पर विशेष ध्यान दिया जाना चाहिए। उनका किसी भी स्तर पर शोषण नहीं होना चाहिए। इन उद्देश्यों की पूर्ति के लिए भी 'बाल दिवल' का आयोजन होता है।

इस अवसर पर विद्यालयों में समारोहो का आयोजन होता है। इस अवसर पर बच्चों द्वारा कविता, गीत, नाटक, भाषण आदि के कार्यक्रम किए जाते है तथा कई विद्यालयों में खेल प्रतियोगिताएँ भी आयोजित की जाती है। उन प्रतियोगिताओं में विजयी छात्रों को पुरस्कृत भी किया जाता है। दिल्ली में शिक्षा विभाग की ओर से यह दिवस सामूहिक रूप से नेशनल स्टेडियम में मनावा जाता है, जहाँ सभी विद्यालयों से चुने हुए विद्यार्थी एकत्रित होते है तथा अपने चुने हुए कार्यक्रम दर्शकों के सम्मुख प्रस्तुत करते हैं।

बहुत से बच्चे इस दिन अपने प्रिय चाचा नेहरू की समाधि पर 'शांति वन' में जाकर श्रद्धा सुमन चढ़ाते हैं तथा चाचा नेहरू के बताए हुए मार्ग पर चलने की प्रतिज्ञा करते हैं। इस दिन बच्चों को नेहरू जी का स्मृति चिन्दू 'सुलाब का फूल' तथा मिठाइबाँ दी जाती है। इस प्रकार प्रसन्नता और मनोरंजन के साथ 'बाल दिवस' का आयोजन संपन्न होता है।

A School is an institution designed for the teaching of students under the direction of teachers. Most countries have systems of formal education, which is commonly compulsory. In these systems students progress through a series of schools. The names of these schools vary by country, but generally include Primary School for your children and Secondary School for Teenagers who have completed Primary Education. 





It was a good celebration and enjoyable moment for all students.






